BRITISH ELITE HORSE SHOW RULES

NCPA QUALIFYING RULES

The show is a qualifier for the NCPA pony of the year show and the Part Bred Welsh ridden championship held in conjunction with the NCPA pony of the year show 2010. 1st and 2nd prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify and the highest not qualified in the first 6 for part bred welsh in appropriate classes.

All classes are qualifiers except 15,16,17,24,29,30,31,32,33,34,41,42,43,44,65,66,67,73,74,75,76,77,78,79,80,81,82,83,84

BRITISH ELITE SHOW RULES

Competitors of the British Elite Horse Show, do not need to be affiliated or members of any society except for classes offering qualification. **Non members** can **compete** but are not eligible to qualify. All persons entering, competing or otherwise being present at the show, whether members or not, are subject to the constitution of the British Elite show including disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the British Elite committee.

Owners entering animals do so, entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attached itself to the promoters or organizers in any respect whatsoever. Riders must be of the correct age for the height of the class.

All classes are confined to mares/geldings, 4 yr old and over.

Stallions and colts are permitted to compete in Inhand, Mountain and Moorland and colored classes aslong as handler/rider is the correct age.

HATS THAT CONFORM TO BRITISH SAFTEY STANDARDS MUST BE WORN WHEN MOUNTED

Displaying of marks - Unfortunately due to the evening performance, we will not be able to display marks; however we will gladly send them out to you after the show. Please send a stamped addressed envelope to the secretary requesting the classes you need to see.

Clashing of classes - Whilst every effort has been taken to avoid clashing of classes, this may be unavoidable. The British Elite reserves the right to alter/amend the schedule as they see fit. No refunds of entries will be given if competitors are entered in classes that clash.

FAMILY PRODUCED ELIGIBILITY (with exception of classes 73 to 78 and 80 which are run under the rules of the vets and ROR societies).

Animals must not have been on a professional producers/trainers yard since 1st January in the current year. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a professional producer/trainer at any show since 1st January in the current year.

Animals and riders must not receive any help from a professional producer/trainer at any show including transporting animals to and from the show since 1st January in the current year. The definition of a professional producer/trainer is a person who undertakes the preparation or production of horses or ponies belonging to other exhibitors for the show ring. Animals must not be ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a professional producer or trainer

The British Elite committee expects competitors to accept the rules of this competition in the spirit intended.

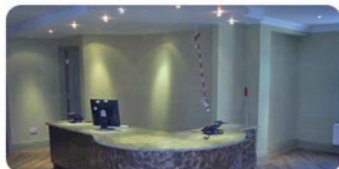

- Class 9** British Elite family produced Lead Rein Show Hunter type of the Year not exceeding 122 cm. Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year
- Class 10** British Elite family produced Show Hunter of the year exceeding 122cm but not 133 cm. Rider not to have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January in the current year
- Class 11** British Elite family produced Show Hunter of the year exceeding 133cm but not 143cm. Rider not to have attained their 17th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
- Class 12** British Elite family produced Show Hunter of the year exceeding 143cm but not 153 cm. Rider not to have attained their 20th birthday by 1st January in the current year
- Class 13** British Elite family produced Show Hunter of the year not exceeding 122cm. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

FAMILY PRODUCED SIDE SADDLE CLASSES

JUDGE MRS. M BROWN

- Class 15** The Side Saddle Association Equitation Championships Open qualifying class. (Open class, adults / juniors) run under S.S.A rules defined in the current members handbook. Open to S.S.A members and non members. Members carrying their current championship point's cards are eligible for S.S.A rosettes to 3rd adult and 3rd junior places, and S.S.A championship points. Side Saddle International offer a rosette to the Adult member for Best Turned out. Manor Grange Stud Show Centre offer a rosette to the Junior member for Best Turned out.
- Class 16** The Side Saddle Association Classical Ladies Side Saddle Qualifying class, Open to S.S.A members and non members aged 16 and over on January the 1st of the current year. Riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2 hds). To be judged on 25% conformation and action, 25% manners and way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turn out of horse and rider. Class to be judged by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, Ponies (UK) or S.S.A panel judge.
Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits and horses will not be stripped.
Traditional habits must be worn, Fancy dress and period costume are NOT permitted.
Nb Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class.
Judges may use a mark sheet as a guide, but is not obligatory.
A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed member of the S.S.A, carrying their current championship point's card.
The highest placed horse / rider combination qualifies for the final to be held at the National Side Saddle show (2010) In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to 4th place.
Qualifying combinations are required to become full members of the S.S.A 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle show to be eligible to compete at the final.
- Class 17** The Side Saddle Concours de Elegance - The sole criteria for this class is the elegance of the horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter, no individual show is required, but the judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays. 3 special rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed adult riders wearing a silk hat, and to the highest placed rider wearing a bowler hat and the highest placed junior providing they are members of the S.S.A Nb silk hats are permitted to be worn by adults.
Juniors must wear hats to British safety standards or above for this class.
Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.
